The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 34 dated 18.08.2020, under Sections 328, 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the complainant had been administered phenyl. He, however, contends that the petitioner and his family members have been falsely implicated, as there were differences in the matrimonial life of the petitioner and the complainant and they have preferred a petition for divorce by mutual consent. Later, the complainant had started demanding money which was beyond the capacity of the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner himself had taken the complainant to the hospital and had paid her medical expenses.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he had forcibly administered phenyl to the complainant. It is also alleged in the FIR that after the birth of a female child, the complainant was harassed and tortured by the petitioner and his family members. She had been thrown out of the house and later with the intervention of the respectables, she had come back to the house and was forcibly administered phenyl. The first petition preferred by the petitioner for anticipatory bail had been dismissed as withdrawn on 29.10.2020. In view of serious allegations against the petitioner, I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
