Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for issuance of directions to official respondents to look into the representation dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 05.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage of the petitioner was performed with respondent No. 6-Lovish Watts on 21.11.2019, whereas the other private respondents are the in-laws of the petitioner.

Learned counsel further submits that the marriage of the petitioner could not pull on and on account of that, aforesaid two representations were given to the police authorities, however, no action has been taken thereon so far.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that this petition may be disposed of with a direction to

respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the grievances of the petitioner and dispose of the aforesaid representations in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the grievances of the petitioner and dispose of the aforesaid representations in accordance with law, within a period of two months from today.

It is made clear that while disposing of the aforesaid representations, the police authorities shall follow the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court laid down in *Lalita Kumari vs. State of U.P. and others, 2013 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 979* and will afford an opportunity of hearing to both the parties.
