The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 597 dated 26.6.2020, under Sections 397/451 IPC and under Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 307/324 IPC deleted in final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C) registered at Police Station City Jagadhari.

The grievance raised was that only one official witness was examined, information was sought from trial Court. As per the communication received from Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, the trial was progressing. Report dated 16.8.2021 is received wherein it is stated that nine prosecution witnesses have been examined.

There are total sixteen witnesses and the matter is now fixed for 1.9.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that earnest efforts

would be made to examine all prosecution witnesses latest by 30.10.2021.

In view of statement made, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with liberty to revive the petition in case there is an inordinate delay.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned to accommodate the date to conclude the prosecutions evidence before 30.10.2021, the same will be considered in accordance with law.
