By filing this petition, quashing of FIR No.111 dated 20.05.2019 registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station P.S. City Ferozepur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners has been sought on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 11.01.2021, parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned on 17.02.2021 for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Ferozepur has been received wherein it is stated that compromise entered into between the parties which is voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence from either side.
