This petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the official respondents to either allot/allocate the construction work of multi level parking in front of Bus Stand and Cloth Market at Ambala City in pursuance to the DNIT dated 27.08.2019 to the petitioner being L-1 as per the prevalent market rate as an EMD of Rs. 25.12 lacs is lying deposited with respondent No. 5 or return the said amount alongwith interest at the rate of 12% per annum in case the official respondents do not allot the same to it.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed a legal notice/representation dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) before the respondent-authorities which is pending consideration.

Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits that the respondent-authorities shall consider and pass a detailed order on the legal notice/representation filed by the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, we do not find any reason to entertain the present petition which is disposed of. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
