(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from harm at the hands of respondents 4 to 9.

Status report by way of affidavit of Rakesh Agrawal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in the Registry which is taken on record.

In the above said status report, it has been mentioned that the petitioners had stated in their statements that now they have no threat from respondents No.4 to 9. It has been further mentioned that the concerned SHO has also been directed to ensure safety and security of the petitioners through police patrolling.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 7 to 9 has submitted that respondents No.7 to 9 have no objection to marriage of the petitioners and there would be no threat of any physical harm to any of the petitioners from their side.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that now the petitioners do not have any apprehension of danger to their life and liberty and the petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to approach this Court in case of any apprehension of danger to their life and liberty.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
