This petition has been filed by the petitioners praying for a direction to the respondent-authorities to continue admissions in Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course for the session 2020-2021 in the District Institutes of Education and Training (DIETs).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they have not yet made any representation before the respondent-authorities in this regard. He submits that the petitioners shall do so within a week.

Mr. Deepak Balyan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits that the Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.) course has been stopped at District Level since 2018 and is being continued in six institutions in the State of Haryana. He submits that in case the petitioners make a representation before the authorities, the same shall be considered and decided by them and the order passed thereon shall be communicated to the petitioners within four weeks.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, we do not find any reason to entertain the present petition which is disposed of taking the statement of learned State counsel on record. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to consider and decide the representation within four weeks from the date of receipt thereof keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
