Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.3 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that son of the petitioner, namely, Mandeep Singh and his wife, namely, Jaswinder Kaur-respondent No. 5 were out of her control and, therefore, the petitioner disowned them from her property in the year 2018. Due to love and affection, the petitioner executed a will dated 01.11.2019 (Annexure P-5) in favour of her grandsons. Later on, the son of the petitioner died in England due to Covid-19 on 14.04.2020. Now, respondent No.5 i.e. daughter-in-law of the petitioner, has shifted to the first floor of the petitioner's house and filed a civil suit against the petitioner, Bhupinder Singh and Manjit Kaur, son and daughter of the petitioner.

In this case, notice of motion was issued to respondent No.5 only.

Mr. Navraj Singh, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent No. 5 and files his power of attorney through email, the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 i.e. daughter-in-law of the petitioner, categorically states that Jawinder Kaur-respondent No.5 has never extended any threat to the petitioner and the petitioner is residing on the ground floor and in future also, respondent No.5 will not extend any threat to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the statement given by the learned counsel for respondent No.5, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed being not pressed.
