The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.504 dated 26.12.2020, under Sections 21(b) and 27-A of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, district Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, namely, Amandeep @ Aman from whom 101 grams of heroin has been recovered. He also contends that besides the statement of co-accused, there is no material which would connect the petitioner with the commission of the offence.

This Court, by order dated 11.01.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Sadiram, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 11.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
