This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.223 dated 02.06.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code and subsequently added Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonipat, District Sonipat.

[2]. With reference to the noting made in Para No.3 of the last order passed on 18.01.2021, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has sent up through e-mail a copy of the order dated 12.01.2021 passed by the Ld. Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sonipat in CIS No. B.A. 62 of 2021.

[3]. Perusal of the same goes to show that co-accused Yashpal @ Toofan has been granted regular bail after having undergone detention for more than 3½ years, since 03.06.2017, in view of the fact that he is not involved in any other case and that trial of the case has been stayed at the very initial stage as a consequence of the proceedings being stayed by this

Court, in view of the revision preferred by co-accused Mohit and Rohit.

[4]. Similarly, co-accused Jogender @ Joga and Sumit have been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-41864-2020 and CRM-M-36805-2020, respectively.

[5]. The present petitioner has also remained in custody in the present case for more than 3½ years, since 24.07.2017, and there is also no record of his involvement in any other criminal case.

[6]. As such, considering all the above circumstances, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is similarly permitted to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
