This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to further direct respondent No.3 to release the possession of the motor cycle Bajaj Pulsar bearing registration No.PB-10 0612 to the petitioner which has been illegally taken away by the police personnel of Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that the registration certificate of the motor cycle bearing No.PB-10 0612 is not in his name. It is the case of the petitioner that few persons in police uniform came and took the motorcycle from his residence.

However, Mr. Deol, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh has stated that none of the police officials from Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga visited the house of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no case is made out for interference.
