Vide this application, the applicant, who is the petitioner in the accompanying petition, bearing CRM-M no.1218 of 2021, seeks to withdraw that petition itself, by which he is seeking to be admitted to 'regular bail', upon FIR no.288, dated 30.10.2020, having been registered at Police Station Sadar, Narwana, District Jind, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 346/354-D of the IPC, Section 12 of the POCSO Act, 2012, and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

On 14.1.2021, the following order had been passed by this court in the petition:-

“Case heard by video conference.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

the alleged victim was 15 years old, now her parents do not wish to pursue the complaint made.

However, the State is directed to file an affidavit also giving therein the antecedents of the petitioner because as per learned State counsel even an obscene message was sent by the petitioner, who is shown to be 23 years old, to the victim who was about 15 years old.

Adjourned to 26.03.2021.

A gazetted officer would file a reply to the petition.”

Today, this application has been filed seeking to withdraw the petition.

The application is allowed and the main petition, i.e. CRM-M-1218 of 2021, is dismissed as withdrawn.
