By filing this petition, quashing of FIR No.26 dated 20.02.2020 registered under Sections 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners has been sought on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 12.01.2021, parties were directed to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned on 08.02.2021 for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned JMIC, Kharar has been received wherein it is stated that compromise entered into between the parties which is voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence from either side.

In view thereof, the petition is allowed. FIR No.26 dated 20.02.2020 registered under Sections 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
