The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.096, dated 21.11.2020, under Sections 354-C, 354-D and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 66(E) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 01.04.2021, reproduced herein as under:-

"Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners and the complainant belong to the same caste, therefore, the provisions of SC & ST Act are not attracted in the case."

vide which the petitioner was extended the concession of interim bail, they have joined investigation.

Learned State Counsel has also apprised this Court on

instructions that in compliance of order dated 01.04.2021 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and the petitioners are thus no longer required for further interrogation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 01.04.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
