The prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to the trial court at Dasuya for early disposal of case, titled as “State of Punjab v. Charanjit Singh” arising out of FIR No. 176 dated 2.7.2015, under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 30 and 54 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

There is nothing on record to show that counsel for the petitioner ever made a request before the trial court showing willingness to argue the matter as per the prevailing COVID-19 situation.

In the present scenario, there is no doubt that if the petitioner makes a request for final arguments, the same would be considered by the trial court in accordance with law.
