The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4.

Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into his representation dated 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 06.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.
