Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners are stated to be residents of Talvan Road Phillaur, State of Punjab.

Grievance raised in the petition is that a meat shop has started operations on 26.12.2020 on the street in question and within 150 meters from a mandir which is known as Mata Vaishno Devi Mandir.

Innocuous prayer raised by counsel is that a representation dated 28.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar as also SDM, Phillaur has been made to ensure that such meat shop is either closed or shifted but no action thereupon has been taken.

During the course of hearing, counsel was called upon to advert to particular provision/instruction which would contain an embargo as regards a meat shop being opened within 150 meters of a religious place.

No such provision/instruction has been pointed out to the Court.

Even the averments made in the petition are lacking in such regard.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel seeks withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to file a petition afresh with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
