Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Reply, by way of affidavit dated 27.08.2021 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barara, District Ambala, filed on behalf of respondent-State, through e-mail, is taken on record.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 264 dated 23.12.2020 registered under Sections 323, 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Barara, District Ambala.

Vide order dated 13.01.2021, passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the earlier on the same facts, the complaint was filed by the mother of the complainant and the petitioner approached the Sessions Court, in which, directions was issued that three days prior notice has to be given to the petitioner before taking any action and now in order to circumvent the said directions, the present complaint has been filed by the daughter of the

He further states that the petitioner had made all necessary arrangement for sending the complainant to Ukraine and also arrange for visa and tickets. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation but the amount of Rs. 4 lacs is yet to be recovered.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
