Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 14.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No. 5 to 14 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 14. The certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-5. Petitioner No. 1 has submitted a representation dated 07.01.2021 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No. 2. This is an inter-caste marriage.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

At this stage, Mr. G.S. Goraya, Advocate, appears and files power of attorney on behalf of respondent No. 9-Surjit Singh-paternal uncle of petitioner No. 1, the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 9 submits that they wants to meet petitioner No. 1 to know about her well being only.

As the father of petitioner No. 1 is not appearing and it is her paternal uncle-respondent No. 9, who is making a request for meeting petitioner No. 1, this Court does not find any substance in the prayer made.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana, to decide the representation dated 07.01.2021 (Annexure P-7) of petitioner No. 1 and grant protection to them, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
