SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. In FIR No. 36 of 28.10.2018, registered at Police Station Block Majri, District SAS Nagar, offences constituted under Sections 307, 342, 452, 353, 186, 427, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, and, Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, are embodied.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits, that the bail petitioner is named, as an accused in the afore drawn FIR. However, the learned State counsel on instructions meted to him, by ASI Paramjit Singh submits, that he did not use any incriminatory weapon of offence, during the course of the happening of the penally inculpable occurrence. Consequently, also there was no necessity for the bail petitioner to cause recovery thereof, at this instance, to the investigating officer.

3. Furthermore, the learned State counsel on instructions meted to him, by ASI Paramjit Singh, has reported to this Court, that the bail petitioner has rendered befitting and able co-operation to the investigating officer concerned, in the investigations carried by him, into the offences (supra).

Therefore, and, also when it is submitted before this Court, by the learned State counsel that the investigations into the afore drawn FIR are complete, and, that a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is to be filed before the learned Magistrate concerned.

4. Consequently, the order made by this Court on 15.01.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, subject to the bail petitioner rendering co-operation to the investigating officer concerned, as and when his co-operation is solicited through a written *hukamnama* served upon him, by the investigating officer concerned.
