Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 87 dated 23.09.2019, under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act No.54 of 1959, registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. He further contends that the petitioner himself had received nasal bone fracture (Annexure P-3). He also contends that the matter has been compromised.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 21.01.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Takwinder Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery is yet to be made.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 21.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
