The petitioner is the member of a Scheduled Caste notified in the State of Haryana. She migrated to the State of Rajasthan after her marriage. Her grievance presently is that she is not being given the benefit of reservation by the State of Haryana despite instructions to that effect by the Government of Haryana, *vide* letter No.4/7678-SW(1) dated 13.09.1984, and the judgment of the Supreme Court in **Bir Singh v/s. Delhi Jal Board and others (Civil Appeal No. 1085 of 2013 decided on 30.08.2018)**. The petitioner's representation to the authorities in this regard, made on 16.12.2020, is yet to evoke a response.

As it is for the authorities concerned to consider the petitioner's claim in the light of the relevant Government instructions and the applicable law in the first instance, it would be premature for this Court to adjudicate upon the issue at this stage.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondent authorities to consider the petitioner's representation dated 16.12.2020 on its own merits and in the light of the law laid down by the Supreme Court expeditiously and in any event, not later than three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
