GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Dr. Yogesh Yadav, stated to be aged 29 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to the respondent-authorities for staying the operation of the transfer order of the petitioner from PHC Mandothi (Jhajjar) to Civil Hospital, Jind.

The main grievance of the petitioner in the present petition as is evident from order dated 29.12.2020, is that the petitioner was transferred from Primary Health Center, Mandothi (Jhajjar) to Civil Hospital, Jind.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the State however submits that vide order dated 14.01.2021, the petitioner has been posted and adjusted in Primary Health Center, Rantanthal (Rewari), against vacant post. This order has been stated to be on his own request and the earlier order dated 29.12.2020 has been cancelled.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions from the petitioner not to pursue the present writ petition any further and withdraw the same.

Request of the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
