RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to consider his claim for the appointment on the post of Airman Group 'Y'.

Pursuant to the previous order, learned Senior Counsel for the respondents submits that he has received the instructions on the aspect. He has received the letter from the authorities, the operative part which is reproduced as under:

“1. Reference is made to signal No.12W/Lgl/30 dated 20 Jan 21 your email dated 23 Jan 21, on the subject.

2. It is intimated that the recruitment process for intake 02/2020 in which the petitioner has participated has already concluded on 03 Sep 2020, all the vacancies have been filled up and the candidates are undergoing training at respective training institutes. Therefore, it is practically impossible to enroll and send

the petitioner for training in the same batch since approximately 05 months of the ongoing training have already elapsed.

3. However, as per the extant policy in vogue, petitioner will be considered for enrolment in intake 01/2021 which is tentatively scheduled in Feb 21, subject to his fitness in pre-enrolment medical examination and fulfillment of other requisite conditions. Enrolment list for intake 01/2021 has been published on 25 Jan 21 on the official website of IAF i.e. www.airmenselection.cdac.in and his name figures in the said list.

4. Accordingly, the same may be apprised to the Hon'ble Court through Govt. Counsel on the next date of hearing.

5. This is for your information and further necessary action.

In view of the above, the petitioner submits that if the respondents act in accordance with the above said letter then he would be satisfied.

In view of the above, present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to take action in accordance with the above said letter place on record by the counsel for the respondents.
