1. The present writ petitions have been filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to implement order dated 14.11.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the possession of the property in question has been handed over to the petitioner-Bank (in both cases) and as such, the present writ petitions have been rendered infructuous and the same may be dismissed as such.
