The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 138 dated 23.12.2020, under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the unmarried sister-in-law of the deceased. It is alleged in the FIR that the deceased had committed suicide, as he was being harassed by the in-laws of his daughter. He also contends that there is no suicide note.

This Court, by the order dated 13.01.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaswinder

Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 13.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
