The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.239 dated 22.11.2020 under Section 409 IPC and Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Nangal.

Notice of motion was issued on 13.01.2021. Subject to deposit of an amount of Rs.5,50,575/-, the petitioner was allowed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid amount has already been deposited with Chief Judicial Magistrate, Roopnagar and this fact finds mention in

the order dated 01.02.2021 passed by the said Court.

The factum of deposit of the aforesaid amount has been admitted by learned State counsel.

In view of aforesaid position, the order dated 19.01.2021 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Without embarking upon merits, if the amount is found to be deficient, the petitioner would be obligated to make good the additional amount, so as to satisfy the claim of the complainant.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
