The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 as they have been extending threats to the petitioner, physically assaulted and caused her injuries.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into her representation dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) and also to bring certain subsequent developments, which have taken place, to the notice of concerned official respondent.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) – respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

It will be open to the petitioner to bring the developments, which according to the counsel, have taken place after submission of the representation dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-5), to the notice of the concerned respondent.

A copy of the representation dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
