Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition is not being pressed on behalf of the petitioner No.1 and the same be treated only on behalf of the petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the revision of the pay scale keeping in view the resolution of the Board of Administrator of respondent No.2 but, the Government has not taken any action on the said resolution and the non-action on the part of the respondent-Government is causing prejudice to the petitioner as he has not been given the revised pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.2016 keeping in view the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents through legal notice dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with respondent No.1 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P/9) served by the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.1 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P/9), by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
