The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and for registering a criminal case for allegedly attacking the petitioner on 22.11.2020 at about 6.30 p.m. in the area of Jodha Mal Colony.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representation dated 23.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the

official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 23.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
