The present third petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.183 dated 13.07.2017 registered under Sections 365 & 34 IPC (Sections 364, 302 & 201 IPC, added later on) at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

The counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has pointed out that the evidence of the prosecution, as well as, the defence is already over. The trial court is proceeding with hearing of the final arguments. In view of the above, this court does not find any ground to interfere so as to grant bail pending trial to the petitioner. However, since the trial is at concluding stage, the trial court is directed to decide upon the trial, as

expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed.
