Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, the petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty from the hands of private respondents, who have cheated him.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell with respondents No.4 and 5, whereby the private respondents had received Rs.5.50 lacs from the petitioner. However, since the agreement did not materialize, a compromise dated 01.06.2019, Annexure P-1, was affected between the parties, whereunder the respondents issued post dated cheques in favour of petitioner, which were dishonoured on presentation. Counsel submits that whenever the petitioner insisted on the return of his money, private respondents threatened him with dire consequences and he submitted a representation dated 14.10.2019, Annexure P-2, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2.

However, according to the counsel, the representation has not been attended to. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation, Annexure P-2.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations made in the writ petition or in the representation submitted by the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur - respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 14.10.2019, Annexure P-2, and take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of the order as well as copy of the representation be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur - respondent No.2, in order to enable him to do the needful within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.
