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**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 29.12.2020 under Section 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 18.01.2021: -

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, complainant Dilpreet Singh has transferred Rs. 15,45,000/- in the account of Parminder Singh, who is the husband of the present petitioner, for sending him to Canada as Parminder Singh is running an IELTS institute and immigration*

*centre. It is further submitted that there are further allegations that an amount of Rs. 4,00,000/- was given to Parminder Singh in cash.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no allegation that any amount was transferred to the account of petitioner and she has been involved just because she is the wife of aforesaid Parminder Singh.*

*Learned counsel further submits that even the complainant party has agreed to purchase some land from the husband of the petitioner, who had entered into an agreement to sell dated 21.06.2019, which the complainant party is claiming to be a forged document, however, it raises a civil dispute.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the amount was paid to Parminder Singh prior to execution of aforesaid agreement to sell and the investigation qua said agreement to sell is still going on...”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Barjinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more

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required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.01.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
