The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for ensuring release of detenue-Paramjit Kaur (friend of the petitioner) from illegal custody of respondents No.5 and 6 by appointment of a warrant officer.

Learned Counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 has filed his power of attorney through e-mail print out of which is taken on record. Original power of attorney be filed in the Registry.

Vide order dated 18.01.2021 this Court had directed respondents No.5 and 6 to ensure presence of detenue-Paramjit Kaur before this Court through video conferencing for today but respondents No.5 and 6 have not ensured presence of detenue-Paramjit Kaur before this Court through video conferencing today.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and respondents No.5 and 6 have compromised and respondent No.5 has agreed to solemnization of marriage of Paramjit Kaur with the petitioner. The petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Learned Counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 has not disputed the factual position explained by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
