The case has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of pre-arrest bail in case
bearing FIR No.280 dated 20.11.2020, registered under
Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149, 506, 295 of IPC at Police
Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

As per FIR i.e. in the statement of Ranjit Singh, the
allegation against the petitioner is of catching hold of the
complainant, thereby facilitating others to cause injuries. The
petitioner has not been attributed any injury on the person of the
complainant.

Notice of motion was issued and arrest of the petitioner was also stayed.

Learned State counsel duly assisted by learned counsel for the complainant however opposed the bail to the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct the petitioner to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 07.04.2021 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.

The petition stands disposed of.
