The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.83 dated 08.05.2020, registered under Sections 452, 324, 447, 506, 148, 149, 427 IPC (Sections 326 and 323 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and his family members are in possession of the land in question for which the Civil Suit was filed by co-accused Sukhdev Singh in which interim order has been granted by the Civil Court thereby restraining the Gram Panchayat and Mukhtiar Singh, Sarpanch from interfering in the possession of

Sukhdev Singh. It is a case of version and cross-version. The

petitioner has also received grievous injury on his person. Injury No.3 is the amputation of right index finger and the same was inflicted with a sharp edged weapon (drati). Injuries are on fingers on both sides and these injuries have been declared as grievous injuries. In the cross version, Balwinder Singh has been granted anticipatory bail, vide order dated 09.09.2020 passed in CRM-M-19316-2020.

Notice of motion was issued on 15.01.2021 and the arrest of the petitioner was also stayed.

In view of aforesaid, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 07.04.2021 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from

- disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
