2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.09.2019 passed in CWP No.23995 of 2019.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the directions issued in the aforementioned writ petition having been complied with by releasing payment of Rs.1,29,757/-, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while directing respondent No.2 to furnish the petitioner a copy of the calculation sheet on the basis of which payment was released.

furnish a copy of the calculation sheet of the payment made to the

petitioner, within two weeks from today.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed.
