Heard, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sh. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner claims that he is senior to respondent No.4. It is also pleaded that in the seniority list of clerks issued on 05.09.2000, the petitioner was assigned Serial No.146, whereas, respondent No.4 was assigned seniority No.186. The petitioner and respondent No.4 were promoted as Assistant on the same day.

Another seniority list of Assistants was issued on 31.01.2017, wherein, petitioner was placed before respondent No.4. The petitioner now claims that seniority of respondent No.4 has been re-fixed and he has been ordered to be promoted as Deputy Superintendent, whereas, the petitioner has submitted a representation on 25.02.2020 which has not been considered.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, it is considered

appropriate to direct the Commissioner, Hisar, Division Hisar, to decide the representation allegedly submitted by the petitioner on 25.02.2020 with a speaking order, after granting opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

This Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and the Commissioner, Hisar, Division Hisar, is expected to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of two months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
