Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.150 dated 15.12.2020 under Sections 22, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985,
registered at Police Station Sadar, Rajpura.

Vide order dated 15.01.2021, this Court while granting the
concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join
investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh
states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial
interrogation is no longer required.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated
15.01.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made
absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when
called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the
conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
