SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.86 dated 29.10.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, (Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

On 30.01.2020, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature and there is cross-version also.

List on 25.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Kewal Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioners are not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
