Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No. 189 dated 04.12.2020, registered under Sections 363, 366-A of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka, along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

On the last date of hearing, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioners. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, submits that petitioner No. 1 has performed marriage with respondent No. 2, who is stated to be aged about 16 years and was not competent to perform marriage in view of the provisions of the Prohibition of the Child Marriage Act, 2006.

Learned State counsel further submits that there is no

compromise between the parties.

In view of the above, I find no ground to quash the impugned FIR.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
