By way of this appeal, the unsuccessful petitioner in CWP-4262-2020 seeks to assail the order dated 17.02.2020 passed by a learned Judge of this Court dismissing the said writ petition. Perusal of the order reflects that certain arguments were advanced before the learned Judge by the counsel who had then appeared for the petitioner. Basing on the said arguments, the learned Judge recorded certain findings that led to the dismissal of the writ petition.

Mr. Baltej Singh Sidhu, learned counsel for the appellant-petitioner, fairly concedes that the arguments that he now seeks to advance before this Court were not urged before the learned Judge. He would seek leave to withdraw this appeal reserving liberty to the appellant-petitioner to approach the learned Judge and seek leave to present the full facts and the contentions based thereon.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn leaving it open to the appellant-petitioner to do so in accordance with due procedure.
