Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 142 dated 25.04.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 323, 324 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had fired solitary shot which hit the left leg of injured-Surya Partap. He also contends that co-accused, namely, Pankaj, Sachin and Karan @ Babu have been granted regular bail. Co-accused, Rajat, who was attributed a shot on the right leg of the complainant, has been declared innocent by the police although a pistol was recovered from him. The petitioner is 23 years of age and is in custody for over a year and three months. The injured has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is involved in two other criminal cases in which he is on bail.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Imtaz Ali states that although the charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined. The matter is listed for prosecution evidence on 29.07.2021.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is 23 year of age, is in custody for over 01 year and 03 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar on every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial. He shall also furnish his mobile number to the SHO of the concerned police station and keep the location of his phone on.
