Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.33 dated 29.4.2019 registered under Sections 376(n), 506 IPC at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 14.1.2020, arrest of the petitioner was stayed.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.1.2020 is made absolute, however, with the modification that the petitioner will be admitted to bail during trial by the trial Court subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds

to its satisfaction. The petitioner will keep on appearing before the trial Court during the trial.

The petition stands allowed.
