MANJARI NEHRU KAUL (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 51 dated 09.07.2019, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, at Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 15.01.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and the dowry articles stand returned.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh does not dispute the said fact and has apprised the Court that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant has opposed the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and has submitted

that the complainant was unaware of the date when the petitioner joined investigation. He further submits that the dowry articles have not been recovered in its entirety.

Heard.

In the wake of the submissions made by learned State counsel as well as the instructions received by him, order dated 15.01.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
