Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite a complaint dated 07.11.2020 (Annexure P-1) having been made to SHO, P.S. Bhikhiwind and thereafter Representation dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) having been made to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, official respondents have failed to take any steps and the life and liberty of the petitioner continuous to be imperil at the hands of private respondents. Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into his representation and take appropriate steps as may be required, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. H.S. Sitta, AAG Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2– Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the Representation dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
