Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 03.11.2020, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Phase-I, district SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no complainant and the FIR has been registered on the basis of secret information wherein it is alleged that the petitioner is luring innocent persons by preparing fake certificates for going abroad. He also contends that the petitioner is running a Skill Development Centre and has been conducting training programmes across North India including State of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan and Uttrakhand. After registration of the FIR, two persons namely Ravinder Singh and Davinder Kaur had filed complaints against the petitioner but the matter has been settled with them. Copies of their affidavits are at Annexures P-13 and P-14. There is no other complaint against the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 05.10.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Pritpal Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but he is not cooperating.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 05.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
