The petitioners are aggrieved by the inaction of the State Registrar, Firms and Societies, Chandigarh, the 1st respondent herein, in the context of their implead application filed in Appeal No.814 of 2020 pending on his file. The subject appeal was filed by the 2nd respondent herein against the 3rd and 4th respondents.

Mr. Sankalp, learned counsel for the petitioners, would state that the subject implead application was filed by his clients as long back as in the month of September, 2020, but the 1st respondent is not passing any orders thereon.

As the petitioners claim to have an interest in the pending appeal and it is for the appellate authority to consider their implead application on its own merits in accordance with law in the first instance, no grounds are made out for this Court to interfere at this stage. That being so, it would not be necessary to put the 2nd and 4th respondents on notice at this stage or afford them an opportunity of hearing.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appearing for the 1st respondent-appellate authority, would inform this Court that the implead application filed by the petitioners would be disposed of, given sufficient time.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the 1st respondent to consider the petitioners' implead application filed in Appeal No.814 of 2020 on its own merits and as per law and pass a reasoned order thereon expeditiously and in any event, not later than 4 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

No order as to costs.
