The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 22.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samana, District Patiala in FIR No. 60 dated 8.4.2017 registered under Section 382 IPC at Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala whereby petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that FIR was registered against unknown persons. Later on, Sharanjit Singh alias Sunny and Gurpreet Singh alias Gopi who were accused in FIR No. 110 dated 13.6.2017 registered under Sections 382, 34 IPC at Police Station City Samana were also made accused in this case. It was on their disclosure statement that petitioner was roped in this FIR.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that petitioner had gone to South Africa on 3.5.2017 and returned on 8.11.2020. He states that before the petitioner was named as accused, he had already gone abroad. No summons were received by him. Even in the report regarding execution of warrants of arrest dated 13.2.2018 issued against petitioner, it has been stated by ASI Harinder Singh that he alongwith other police officials raided house of petitioner and he was not present there and persons who were present in house told them that petitioner had gone abroad. Learned counsel states that it was never the intention of the petitioner to evade process of law. He states that he would appear before the Court to face trial.
