This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.151 dated 07.12.2020 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Reply by way of affidavit of Avtar Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Abohar, District Fazilka, has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dayal Singh submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the main FIR having been quashed on the basis of compromise vide separate order of even date passed in CRM-M-1132-2021, the instant application for anticipatory bail has been rendered infructuous and is accordingly, disposed of.
